Please find attached a copy of the Programme of Assessment for your child/ward.

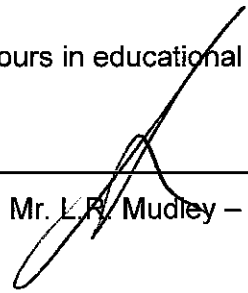
What is a Programme of Assessment?

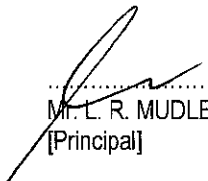
